ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS) is a rapidly progressive and fatal motor neuron disease that there is no known cause of or cure for, and

WHEREAS over 400 British Columbians at any given time are living with ALS in British Columbia, and

WHEREAS ALS, also known as Lou Gehrig's disease, can strike anyone, regardless of age, gender or circumstances, and

WHEREAS recent advances in ALS research have produced promising leads, and this crucial work must be continued, and

WHEREAS the ALS Society of BC is dedicated to providing direct support to ALS patients, along with their families and caregivers, to ensure the best quality of life possible for those living with ALS;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that June 2020 shall be known as


“Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Awareness Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.
